I am pleased to present the 2017-18 Annual Report of the Chinese Cancer and Chronic Illness Society of Victoria (CCCIS).

This has been a landmark year for us: we launched our new charity name and started our Home Care service. As ever, we continue to be very proud of our day to day work and service to our community which we have done over the past 21 years.

Over these decades, our focus has been sufferers and focusing cancer on their carers. But we have now expanded our charity's scope to serve those who are affected chronic illnessby other es. We have incorporated the work of our sister charity, the Chinese Chronic Illness Foundation, and changed our legal name to become the Chinese Cancer and Chronic Illness Society of Victoria Incorporated. In a nod to our heritage and our original mission, our Chinese name, "維省新生會" remains the same. Mr. Tsebin Tchen. Commissioner of the Victorian Multicultural Commission. formally launched our new name in January 2018 at our Australia Day cerebration party. Guests from various agencies including the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre and other palliative care

services attended this commemorative event.



Another milestone was the establishment of the Society's home care service. In partnership with the Brotherhood of St Laurence, we embarked on this service after a few months' rigorous planning. As an independent contractor of Brotherhood of St Laurence, we will provide home care services for their Chinese speaking clients who have been approved for an aged care package. CCCIS Home Care Service - 軒 officially launched 愛,was 2018. One of our staff, Jo, has taken on responsibility the operate this program. We will need time to learn, explore, and develop this side of our service, and I'd encourage people to talk to Jo about this new exciting service.



The outreach work at Peter Mac-Callum Cancer Centre (PMCC) and Box Hill Hospital remains a vital part of our support service. We are very lucky that we have been funded through Westpac Bank and Num Pon Soon Charitable Trust to continue our support to cancer sufferers at the hospitals. Thanks to our staff, Jo and Frieda, for their devotion to meeting the needs of our clients.



Educating about Advance Care Planning is still a major focus for the Society. Earlier this year, we successfully attained a grant through Bendigo Bank to continue this important work. main objective of the grant is to deliver seminars in raising awareness of the sensitive issue of death in the Chinese community. While there are recognised hurdles in talking about death and dying in our community, we strived to approach many senior centres to raise awareness of the new legislation, Medical Treatment Planning and Decisions Act 2016. With the grant, we have updated our Farewell Wishes Booklet and printed 3000 copies each in Mandarin and Cantonese.

We have continued to think of creative ways in getting out our messages. At CCCIS we have a lovely tradition to use drama to talk about life issues. We produced a comical skit, Say Goodbye to Hush Hush, to encourage people to think about their farewell wishes from different perspectives. Thanks to a team of dedicated and passionate volunteers in producing the skit. They rehearsed tirelessly over the past few months to perform this humorous but very important skit this year.



I am pleased to report that our partnerships with organisations such as Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre (PMCC) and Cancer Council Victoria (CCV) in providing cancer support and development of resources in the Chinese language continues. Over the past financial year, we secured a small grant from PMCC to run a survivorship project called On the Road to Recovery. We also assisted CCV to produce a Bowel Cancer Screening video. CCV also funded us a woodwork project to engage male cansufferers to involve more CCCIS. While there was a only small group of participants, they reported that it was enjoyable and that they felt they had achieved something. The Group also attended Sunday markets to showcase their masterpieces.

On a more exciting note, we have been successful in obtaining grants and contractual jobs from the Victorian State Government and other not-forprofit agencies. We were very fortunate to have been funded a 4-year grant through the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to deliver a range of client focused support services to individuals with life-limiting illnesses from Chinese speaking communities metropolitan Melbourne across (currently available in Eastern and South Eastern suburbs only). This is the first time that CCCIS has received a long years.

President's Report

Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre (VCCC)

"On the Road to Recovery" Completed in April 2018

After 18 months' planning and implementation, this project was eventually completed. 2 education forums for Mandarin-speaking Cantonese and cancer survivors and their carers which provide an opportunity for increased awareness of post treatment information for the Chinese community were delivered in March this year. Over 70 people from various hospitals attended the program. Some of the

participants have attended this kind of programs for the first time.

On the Road to Recovery audio and video resources were produced for cancer survivors in Mandarin and Cantonese. Our Staff was involved in the production of the video that involved recruitment of guest speakers and being interviewed.

B. Connected Communities Melbourne and Community Enterprise Foundation (Bendigo Bank) Advance Care Planning Project

CCCIS has in the last 5 months visited 18 community groups and talked to over 500 people about the importance of preparing one's advance care plan (ACP). About 50 -60% participants said they will complete the form within 12 months after learning about advance care planning. Some participants did comment that the process was quite complicated. We also have produced a short video about ACP in Mandarin and Chinese as an additional tool to help people understand the reason for writing down their farewell wishes.

CCCIS advance care planning booklet - My Farewell Wishes has been revised. It is available for people who would like to obtain a copy.

C. Bowel Cancer Screening Video Project (Cancer Council Victoria) Completed in June 2018

Our role in this project was to recruit a Mandarin speaking GP and a local bowel cancer survivor for the produc-



tion of a bowel cancer screening video, check all related translated materials, assist CCV in organising the taping of the video, help with promotion through social media and radios and evaluated the video

D. Good Things Foundations Activation Grants Digital skills Project

We were funded through Good Things Foundation - Be Connected Network, to implement a project in helping older Australians thrive in a digital world. Our objective is to support 30 seniors to develop their digital skills over a 10 month period.





We run Mandarin and Cantonese classes on a weekly basis and currently over 21 students have been registered. Dave So and PS Leung are our tutors.
