

會長報告 President's Report

I am pleased to present the 2016-17 Annual Report of the Chinese Cancer Society of Victoria ("CCSV").

This past year has been one of consolidation and rest for the Society. Without major events to plan, we used the past year wisely to recuperate and explore how we can respond more effectively to the growing Chinese community in Melbourne. As the founder and president of CCSV, I have spent much effort to look for opportunities, partnerships, sponsorships, and to learn more about people's way of life in our society. Within our Society, I realised that our members are quite adept in getting information through social media such as WeChat and Whatsapp. It is a wonder of technology that even elderly people bury their heads in front of their mobile phones, connecting with people around the world. We have also found that there are plenty of events and activities offered to the Chinese community by community organisations, and therefore it appears there is less demand for us to organise recreational activities and parties. As a result, we believe that now is the time to readjust our focus to pro-

vide more quality services to our clients who need extra assistance.

CCSV continues to take pride in delivering timely services to our clients. We embraced 334 new clients in our family support system this past financial year, doubling the new clients that we took on last year. I believe this increase was due to having more staff working in our family support service. We continued to reach out to oncology wards and specialist clinics in different hospitals, e.g. the Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre, client's homes and hospices. We have provided almost 1700 contacts that included individual face-to-face and phone/email support, and other practical assistance such as transport, equipment loans, filling in forms and free wigs. A brief snapshot of our client profile is shown in this annual report.

Importantly, I should point out that CCSV has received more referrals from palliative care services. It reflects the knowledge and skills we have in providing supportive end-of-life care to people who are going through the final days of their life. We are committed to supporting our clients and the general public in preparing their advanced care plan. In fact, we have received mail orders for our Farewell Wishes Booklet from interstates.

Our Centre remains a much loved home of respite, fun and hope. The weekly Box Hill group attracted a lot more cancer sufferers

than other groups affiliated with CCSV. On the whole, the groups are becoming more independent nowadays as they are able to organise functions for their own members. This is an encouraging development and I would like to give credit to all the group facilitators.

As you all know, the Centre is over 70 years old. We must be vigilant to maintain its level of safety. This year we had replaced part of the water pipes underneath the house as ageing has taken its toll on the pipes. Thanks very much to Mandy, our volunteer who had donated the money to finance this repair. Other maintenance included replacing a new fire extinguisher to prevent fire incidents.

I am pleased to see that CCSV continues to have partnerships with organisations such as VCCC (Peter MacCullum Cancer Center), Cancer Council Victoria and Breast

Cancer Network Australia in providing cancer support and developing resources. We received a grant from the South Melbourne Integrative Cancer Service to provide cancer prevention education to the Chinese community in the south-eastern suburbs. The Society, in partnership with its sister charity, the Chinese Chronic Illness Foundation, has expanded its community education in Melbourne's western suburbs.

As we are getting more requests for volunteer placements, I have appointed a volunteer to coordinate referrals from various volunteer resource centres and employment agencies. We envisage a trend for short term volunteer work requested by retirees, students and even professionals. The Society has to adopt new approaches in creating suitable volunteer positions to benefit the community as well as serving the Society itself.



One of the volunteers we recently recruited has developed a new client/membership database for the Society.

I continue sitting on a few advisory committees to provide cultural advice such as Cancer Council Australia and Boroondara Volunteer Resource Centre. I also have supported Banksia Palliative Care to develop their multicultural services.

I would like to mention some highlights in this financial year. In October last year, we organised a family fun day packed with interesting activities with a small grant from the City of Whitehorse. The aim was to foster intergenerational relationships and the event was well received by grandparents, parents and children. We also reactivated our knitting class and started mah-jong, drawing and woodwork classes.

While 2016-17 saw some achievements within the Society, there remains ongoing challenges that the Committee of Management has to respond to. The focus is to generate funds of more than \$100,000 a year to maintain our current service levels and at the same time to expand our services. Our treasurer will explain our financial situation to you after my report.

In closing, I sincerely acknowledge all CCSV volunteers including our committee members, many of whom are cancer survivors them-

selves, for their dedication and compassion. Thank you all for their tireless efforts into this unique family. I would also like to thank Num Pon Soon Charitable Trust and Oriental Merchant for their ongoing support, the generous donations of Lions Club of Melbourne Chinese, ANZ Bank, and those from individual donors. Regrettably, Lily Ong (our committee member) decided to pursue other interests and will step down with effect from 23 September 2017, and Mandy Lee and Arfa Lai have resigned in recent months but remain as volunteers. I wish to extend my personal thanks for their tremendous support and contribution.

And lastly, a quick mention about our compassionate staff, Jo Lu, Wanda Wong and Frieda Si who work diligently to improve the wellbeing of our clients. If you are still in the office at 6pm, you will often see them typing away on their laptops or discussing their work. Thank you, all of you who have supported me to lead CCSV, now widely recognised as a leading Chinese cancer supportive service for over 2 decades.

President's Report

我現在為大家匯報 2016-2017 維省新生會年度報告。

過去一年，是新生會整固和休養生息的一年。去年我們雖然沒有推行甚麼大型的計畫，但我們卻努力探討如何能為不斷增長的墨爾本華人社區提供更適切的服務。作為維省新生會（CCSV）的創始人和會長，我花了不少精力尋找機會，合作夥伴，贊助人，並盡量了解現今社區一般人的生活方式。我意識到我們的會員非常擅長通過 WeChat（微信）和 Whatsapp 等社交媒體獲取信息。在當今的科技下，即使是老年人也會通過手機科技連接世界各地的人。同時，我們也發現目前很多社區組織會為華人社區提供大量活動，似乎新生會再沒有需要費神去安排文娛活動了。有鑑於此，我們相信本會應調整工作重點，以為有特別需要的會員提供更多優質的服務。

新生會為多年來能為客戶提供及時與適切的服務而感到自豪。在過去一個財政年度，我們在家庭支援服務中接納了 334 位新客戶，比去年增加了一倍有多。

我相信這個增加是因為我們聘用了更多員工提供家庭支援服務。我們繼續到不同醫院，例如維省綜合癌症中心的腫瘤科診所及病房，客戶的家和寧養服務院舍進行外展服務。我們為客戶提供了近 1700 次聯繫，包括探訪，電話/電子郵件支持，以及其它實際援助，如交通、設備借用、填寫表格和免費假髮租借等。在本報告中，我們簡單介紹了個案服務的概況。

我必須指出一點很重要的，今年新生會接受了更多的寧養服務的轉介個案，這正好反映我們對臨終關懷服務這個專業有深入的認識。我們致力於協助我們的客戶和公眾準備他們的預設醫療指示（Advanced Care Plan）。事實上，我們已收到其他省份索取本會編製的《我的晚晴意願》小冊子。

維省新生會是一個為會員提供休息、樂趣和希望的驛站。Box Hill 星期二互助小組比其它小組吸引更多癌症患者。總的來說，其他互助小組現在已變得越來越獨立，因為他們已經能為自己的組員組織一些活動。這是一個令人鼓舞的發

展，我在這裏特別感謝各互助小組的組長，多謝他們的努力與付出。

眾所周知，新生會會所已有七十多年，我們必須小心保持會所安全。今年，由於老化對房子的水管造成傷害，我們已經更換了房子地底的食水管。非常感謝我們的義工 Mandy 及她女兒 Eleanor 捐助了此次維修資金。其他維修包括更換滅火器以防止火災事故。

我很高興看到維省新生會繼續與 VCCC (Peter MacCullum 癌症中心)，維省癌症協會和澳洲乳癌網絡等組織建立夥伴關係，為癌症患者提供支持及中文的參考資料。我們收到南墨爾本綜合癌症服務處的一筆撥款，為東南區的華人社區提供癌症預防教育。本會與其姊妹慈善機構華人慢性病基金合作，提供更多的服務和社區教育擴展到墨爾本西區。

務工作。因此維省新生會必須開拓合適的義工職位，使社區和本會同時受益。同時，我們最近招聘的一位義工，按我們的需要與要求，為新生會設計並發展了一個新的客戶/會員數據庫。我繼續擔任幾個諮詢委員會的工作，為他們提供文化諮詢意見，如澳洲癌症協會和 Boroondara 義工資源中心。我也有支持 Banksia 寧養服務發展他們的多元文化服務。

我想指出這個財政年度的一些重點事項。去年十月，我們用 City of Whitehorse 的一筆小額撥款，舉辦了一個家庭同樂日的活動。活動目的是為了促進家庭和諧關係，此次活動得到了祖父母，爸媽和孩子的好評。另外，我們今年也重新開始了編織班，亦舉辦了新的活動如麻將組和木工班。

縱然新生會在 2016-17 年取得一些成就，但管理委員會仍要面臨各種的挑戰。我們需要每年籌集超過\$100,000 資金，以維持我們目前的支出及擴展服務。我們的財務主管將在我的報告後向你解釋我們的財務狀況。

我真誠地感謝所有新生會義工的熱心與貢獻，他們當中有許多更是癌症康復者呢，感謝大家對這個獨特的家庭作出無私奉獻。我要感謝南番順慈善信託基金會和中達食品有限公司的持續支持，慷慨捐款的墨爾本中國獅子會，ANZ 銀行和個人捐助者。可惜的是，Lily Ong, 我們的委員，決定追求其他興趣，將從 2017 年 9 月 23 日起辭退管理委員會的職務，我衷心感謝她的支持和貢獻。

最後，我要在此感謝我們一班積極和熱心的員工 Jo Lu, Wanda Wong 和 Frieda Si, 他們努力為客戶提供高質素的服務。如果你晚上 6 時還在會所，你會經常看到他們在電腦上埋首工作，又或在討論交流他們的工作。多謝大家給我的支持，這令新生會在過去 20 年，成為在墨爾本華人社區癌症支援服務的領導者。

Deliverable

Develop and deliver a post-treatment education forum for Cantonese and Mandarin speaking cancer survivors and their carers Council Victoria

Objectives

1. Develop/adapt an education forum for Cantonese and Mandarin-speaking cancer survivors and their carers, through work with the Chinese community and based on learning's from previous projects.
2. Develop sustainable information resources that can be used by the Chinese community. These resources will be decided through consultation with the Chinese community and may include written or audio visual resources.

Outcomes:

An education forum for Cantonese and Mandarin-speaking cancer survivors and their carers which provides an opportunity for increased awareness of post treatment information for the Chinese community, an opportunity to meet and share experiences (peer support) and increased awareness of where to access post treatment information and support in-language. The forum is scheduled to run in early 2018.

B. Breast Cancer Network Australia (BCNA) *Resources development in Chinese language*

Supported BCNA to host focus groups with Chinese women affected by secondary breast cancer and develop new resources on metastatic breast cancer in Chinese language. One of our members was involved in their video resources. She was interviewed and a short video about her cancer journey was produced in Cantonese.

C. South Melbourne Integrative Cancer Service

South Melbourne Integrative Cancer Service has commissioned us to provide cancer prevention information sessions to Chinese community in the southern




